*In the 1820 locations register, the name of Patrick Bern is entered on lot 4, concession 1 of York Township. The patent map shows his name entered on lot 4, concession 1 in the 1<sup>st</sup> concession east of the town.*

*Proofs submitted to the Commission:*

- a certificate stating that Patrick Bern, aged 22 years, born in Ireland, a turner by trade, has been examined, and has taken the prescribed oaths, and is therefore recommended for a grant of 200 acres provided that the surveyors' books do not show a previous grant in the Province. The certificate is dated June 9, 1795 at York and was signed by David Shank, J.P. The form of the acting surveyor below has been filled in and signed by Alexander Aitken, and assigns to Patrick Bern lot 4 with its broken front, concession 1 of York Township, containing 200 acres. The form is dated June 9, 1795. {vol. 41, pg. 49}*
