This claim is on Provincial Secretary William Jarvis' list of descriptions which were issued, but were found to clash with the Heir and Devisee Commission reports of 1802. Lot 11, concession 5 in Augusta Township has been described (#4426) for Philo Hard, but no deed has been issued.
